

OCEANSIDE DAYS OF ART

SENIOR AND MILITARY EXHIBITOR APPLICATION

A Call for Artists

The Oceanside Cultural Arts Foundation invites Oceanside residents 55 and older (or non-residents in the same age group enrolled in arts classes at Mira Costa College or other Oceanside art venues) and artists either on active duty or retired from military service, to participate in two art exhibit shows in the "Oceanside Days of Art" fine arts event to be held in and about the Oceanside Civic Center area. The event will take place on April 17 and 18, 2010, from 10:00am to 5:00pm each day in two separate venues in the Civic Center area.

The Senior Art Show (for those 55 years and older) will be in Artist's Alley in storefront 212-D, and the Military Art Show will be in the Community Room of the main Oceanside Library in the Civic Center.

Artists are invited to submit entries in the following categories: oils, acrylics, watercolors, pastels, drawing, print-making, sculpture, ceramics, photography, glass and mixed media. No craft, jewelry, bazaar-type or clothing items will be accepted. Entries will be evaluated in a two step process; a pre-selection review to determine show acceptance and a juried process to determine winning entries. No cash awards will be made; Artist works will be recognized as Best of Show, First Place, Second Place, Third Place and Honorable Mention in the categories indicated above. The decisions of the show committee and the jurors will be final.

There is no fee to enter the shows. Artists must submit one application for each art piece submitted for consideration. No sales by Artists at the shows will be permitted. Requests to purchase artworks will be referred directly to each Artist and the end of the show for their further action.

The artwork will be hung on "A" frame boards by committee members in locations determined by the committee. Artist submitting artworks that cannot be hung shall provide their own display method (i.e. pedestal), subject to committee approval. Tables may be provided for ceramics, sculpture and other materials depending upon space availability.

Included with the application to show artwork, the Artist shall provide two to four 4"x 6" photos of the art work proposed for exhibit. No more than three (3) pieces of artwork per Artist will be accepted for the pre-selection process by the committee. It is anticipated Artists will be notified by April 5, 2010, of their selection for the juried show. If their artwork is selected, the Artists will be directed where and when to deliver their artworks for juried show review.

All entries must be original artwork and the Artist's own concept. No giclees or reproductions will be allowed. Paintings and drawings must be properly framed, dried and wired with proper screw eyes and wire for the weight of the piece. No sawtooth hangers will be accepted. Work, including Frame, must not exceed 40 pounds or 50" measured diagonally. The name of the piece (if any), the Artists name, address and phone number must be attached to each entry in a location non-visible to the public. Identification cards for each piece will be provided by the committee.

All artwork MUST be picked up by the Artist on April 18, 2010 between 5:00pm and 6:00pm. The Oceanside Cultural Arts Foundation cannot be responsible for artwork left after the pickup time.

The Artist's application includes a waiver form which MUST be signed by the Artist before the artwork can be considered for the pre-selection process. The copyright of all artwork remains with the creator.

As a participant in the "Oceanside Days of Art" event, the Artist will provide the Oceanside Cultural Art Foundation with permission to photograph the exhibited artwork for publicity and educational uses. No other photographs of the exhibits are permitted.
